

Dog Sledding

Departs 8:30am and 1:30pm (times vary with seasons), allow up to 5.5 hours,

One of our more popular winter tours! We will take you on an interpretive van tour past Mount Robson, the tallest mountain in the Canadian Rockies, to where the dogs anxiously await your arrival. Then the fun begins as you are whisked away by the Alaskan Huskies on a forested trail following the Small River. Try your hand at "mushing"! Fun for all ages.

Tour Director Information:

The dog sled operation is approximately a 1 hour 15 minute van trip west of Jasper. The guests will then experience a professional operation that has operated in the Robson Valley for a number of years. Each sled will have 5 to 7 dogs, and depending on the size of the group, there will be 2 to 3 people per sled. The trail is well packed and follows the Small River up the valley with beautiful winter scenes of the river and limited ones of the mountains. With regular snow through the winter, the area is often the picture of "Winter Wonderland".

There are several programs to choose from:

One hour dog sled – total time 4.5 hours

Moonshiners run – no lunch, approximately 2 hours – total time 5.5 hours

Moonshiners of Whiskey Creek – approx 3 hours with lunch – total time 6-6.5 hours.
