



# Jasper Tramway Trip

Explore the alpine of Whistler's Mountain on a leisurely, interpretive hike. Your guide will bring you to the lower station of the Jasper Tramway, Jasper's Peak Attraction. Enjoy the spectacular views as you ascend nearly 1000 meters (3000 ft) in 7 minutes onboard the tramcar. Once you have reached the top, your interpretive hiking guide will escort you on a leisurely walk. Expect to make a number of stops for photographs and opportunities for interpretive information about the alpine environment and its recent glacial past. Experience the amazing views of the Jasper town-site, Athabasca River, and Front and Main Ranges. On clear days, see Mount Robson, the highest mountain in the Canadian Rockies, towering above all the other mountains, 75 km (45 miles) away. This trip offers the maximum amount of scenery for the least amount of effort. Interpretive topics may include glacial features, the ecology of the alpine and alpine wildflowers. Your guide will escort you back to the tram station for the ride down the mountain, and the return to Jasper. You will have the choice of being dropped off in town by the train station or back at your local accommodations.

Participants are requested to wear comfortable walking shoes/boots, bring rain/wind proof jacket, and a sweater. Please allow 2.5-3 hours for this tour.
